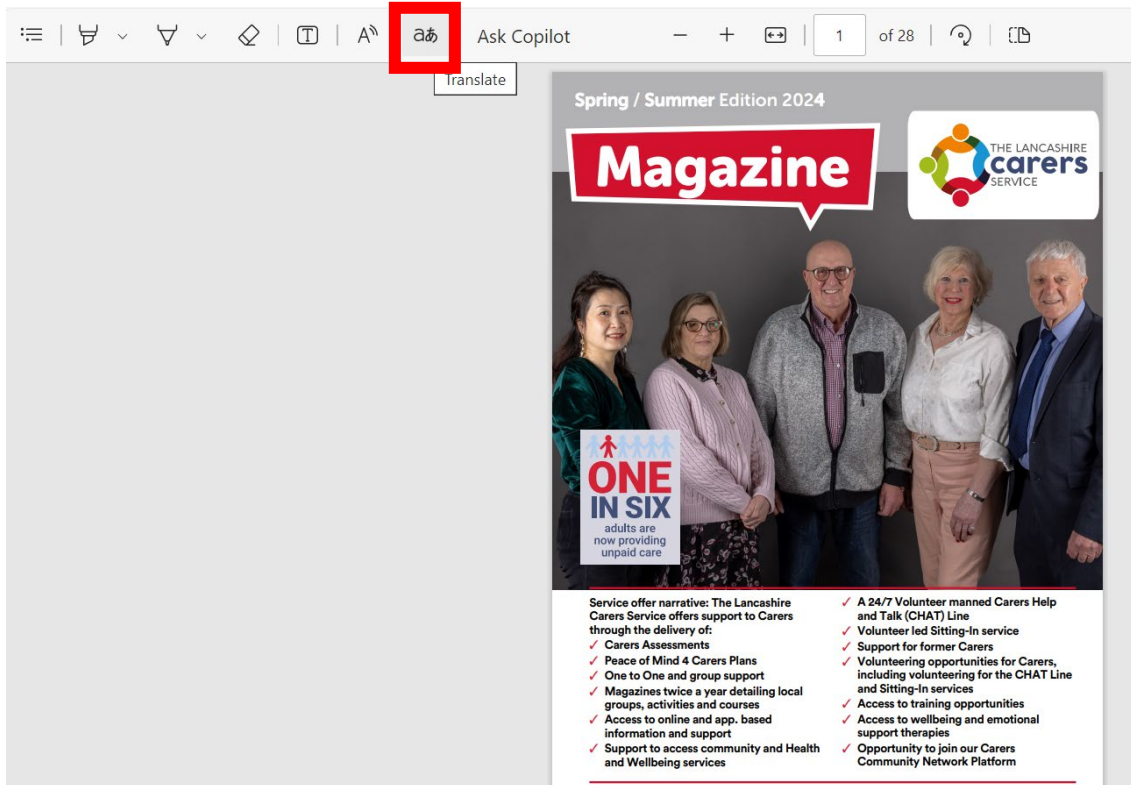


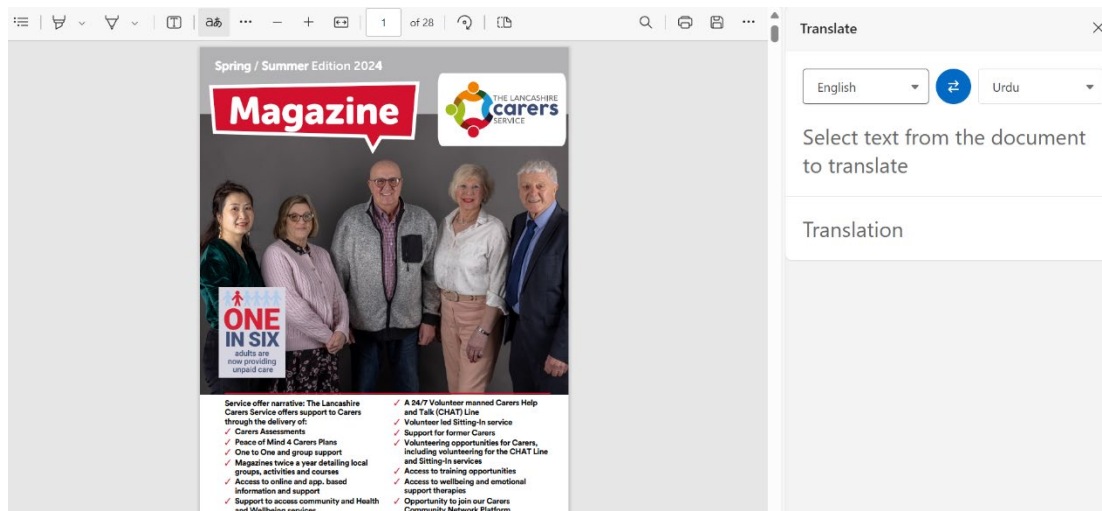
PDF translations- How to

Magazines by PDF – Edge Browser

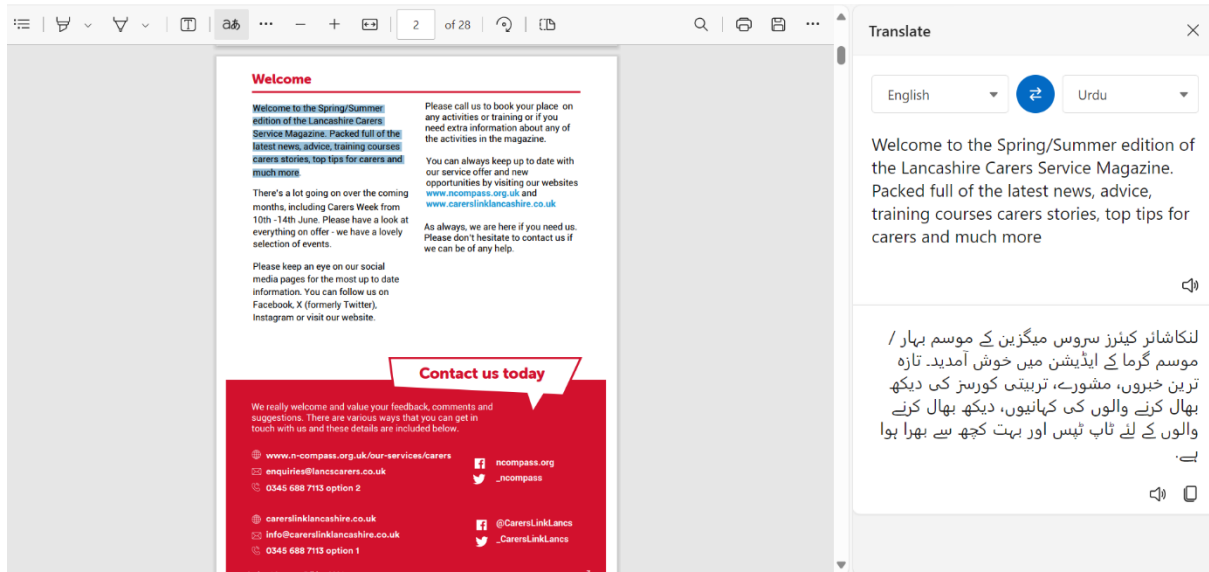
- Open the PDF version of the magazine from our website (<https://www.carerslinklancashire.co.uk/publications>)
- There will be a light grey banner of viewing options across the top of the page
- Click the button shown in the red box below to Translate



- Amend the language in the right hand box to translate into a language of your choice from the drop down menu

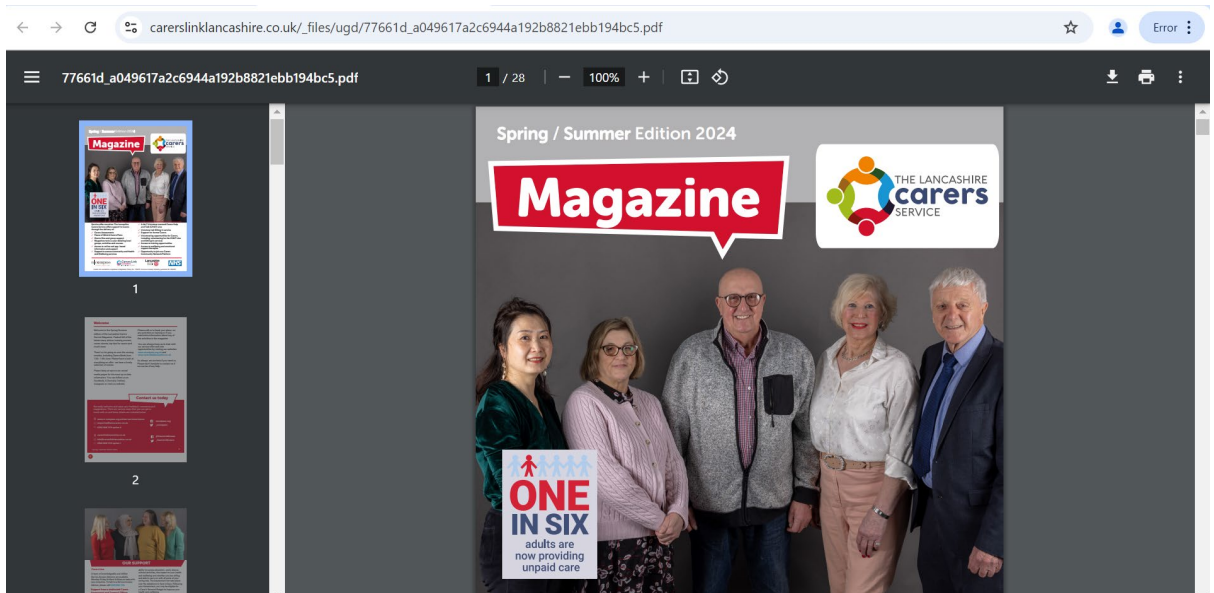


- Select the text to translate and it will appear automatically in the Translation section



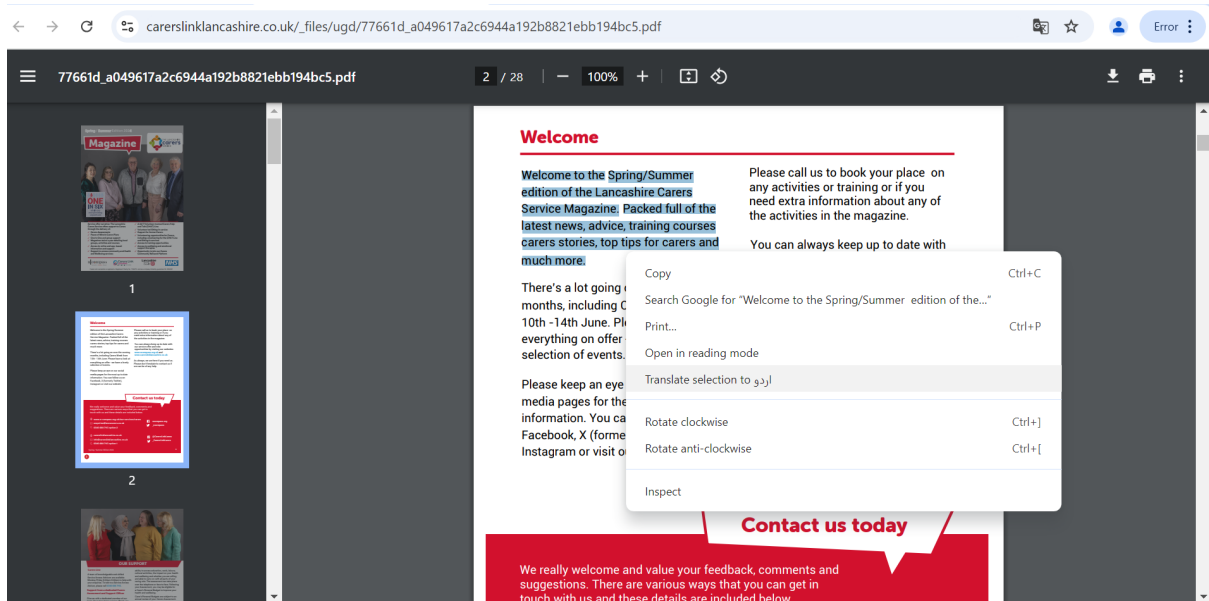
Magazines by PDF – Google Chrome Browser

- Open the PDF version of the magazine from our website (<https://www.carerslinklancashire.co.uk/publications>)
- It should look like the below

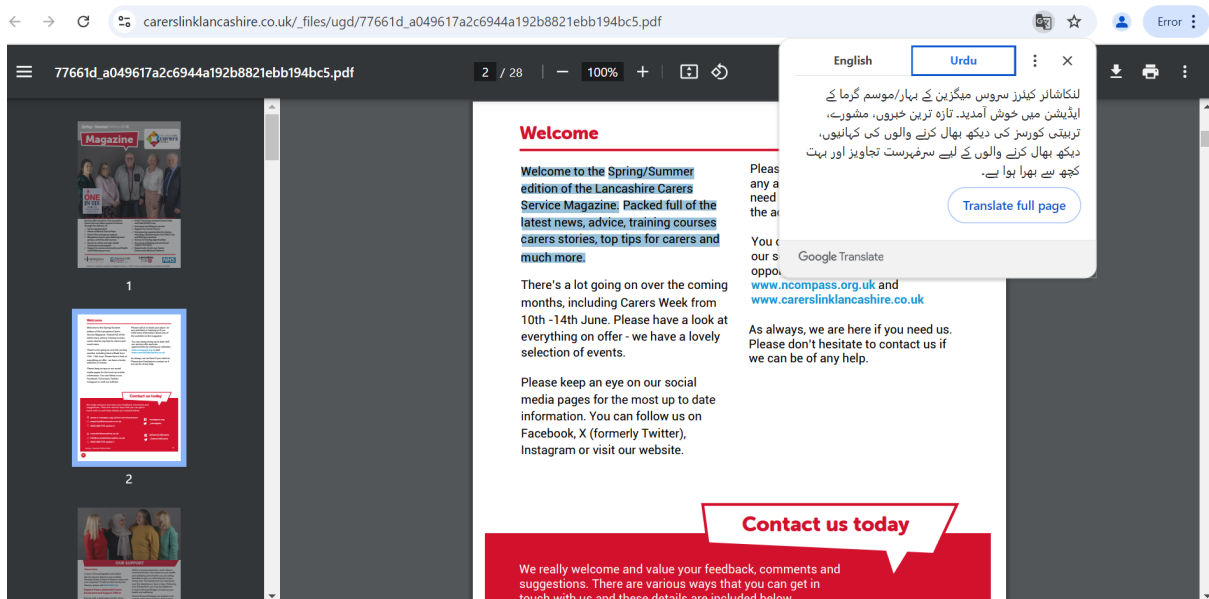


- Highlight the text you wish to translate

- Right click and the menu shown on the below image will appear – select Translate to [any language may pop up, in this image it is Urdu]



- A pop up box of the translation will appear in the top right



- Here it will also give you the option to translate full pages at a time if your computer has the capability to do so – for some it may work, for others it may not depending on the computer.

This process should work for all PDF documents including our Dementia Support Guide, Mental Health Support Guide and Annual Report.
